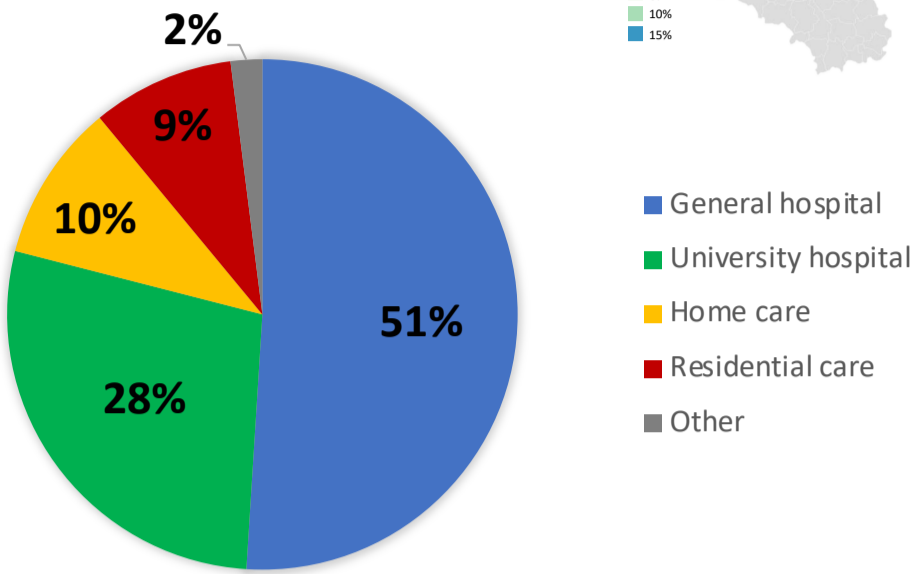
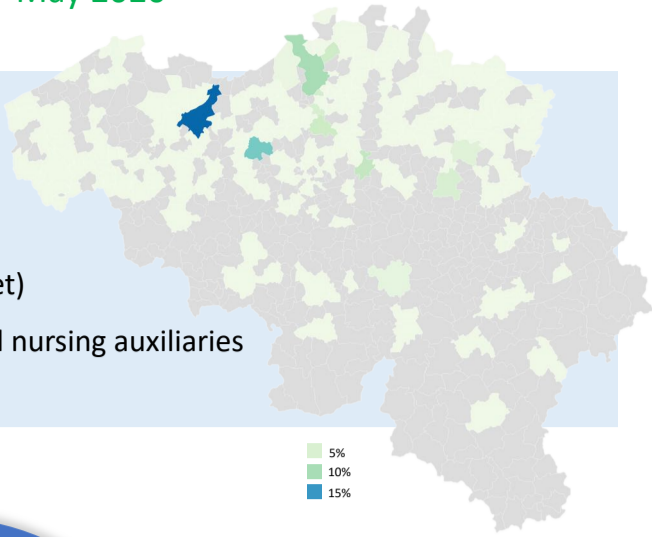


COVID nursing team readiness study

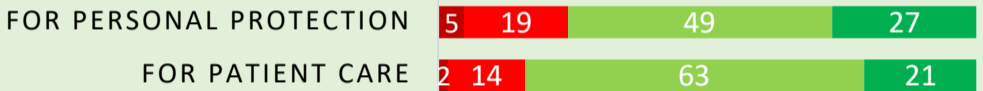
1216 participants
